



Uninstalling the previous application


1 – Go to the “Control Panel” and select the “Uninstall a programme” option



2 – Next, select the “GSS version x.x” application and click on “Uninstall”. A dialogue box will appear asking whether you are sure you want to delete the application completely. Answer yes.



3 – After completing the uninstall, check two folders to ensure any old content from the application is cleaned off the system. Go to “Computer” and the hard disc (by default this is the letter C).



4 – On disc C, delete the GSS folder if it exists. If not, go on to the next step.




5 – All that remains to do is to check whether another folder exists and delete it. To get to this folder follow these steps (for Windows 7).



Press the "Windows" + "Q" keys



On the right of the screen a bar will appear to search the system. Enter the word "Run" and two options in the image on the left will automatically come up. Click on "Run".





This window will appear. Enter:

%appdata%

as shown on the screen and click on "OK"

This will take you to a file manger where you click on "AppData"





In AppData go to the Local folder.

In the Local folder delete the "Girbau" folder. If the folder does not exist then you can go ahead with installing the new application.
